UNIVERSAL DISHWASHER POWER CORD SD69011

STEP 1: Read the installation instructions that come with your appliance completely. Make sure you have purchased a cord that matches the manufacturer's specifications and meets applicable building and/or electrical Standards and Codes.

STEP 2: Locate cord set entry hole and access plate. If required, carefully remove knockout to indicated diameter.

STEP 3: Insert cord, connector end first, snap the plastic retainer end into the knockout hole.

STEP 4: Securely attach connector ends of cord to the appliance in accordance to the installation instructions. Reinstall access plate.

STEP 5: Before plugging new cord into electrical outlet, check continuity of grounding connection between the metal frame of the appliance and the center pin on the cord by using a self-energized circuit tester or other acceptable indicating device.
